Heal the sick: Plant churches: Pastoral Projects:

Mukama Yesu! (Praise Jesus).

It has been a very eventful last few weeks here in Uganda. There have been significant riots and demonstrations in Kampala and across most of Uganda at the rapidly rising prices and the wanton extravagance of the newly elected government. People are doing it very tough here, some of those we know are finding it hard to buy even the basic foods.

We had riot police dressed in full battle gear close by our house recently firing many bullets (whether into the air or the crowds we did not go to find out). It was a bit scary and the locals were terrified. We went through one of the earlier

riots and witnessed 'some things,' even someone who was shot dead. That was not a pretty sight, fortunately Shirley missed that horror. Even this week, Muzungu's (whites/westerners) are being targeted and driven from their homes not far away from us.

Please pray for this country.

Shirley is doing a course here on Permaculture as we prepare to legally take our land and then develop it into an income stream to do ministry, while Mike is seeing many filled with the Holy Spirit. Mike was also the key speaker at a conference during May.

We have submitted our forms for our visa renewals. We are seeking to obtain it for 3 years this time around.

Our land title is progressing and we are hoping to be able to legally take possession of the 20 acres by the end of June. We have recently added 2 more goats to our flock and we have planted more crops.

We have allocated some land on a short term basis to 3 pastors, for growing food.

We have been blessed by some supporters with gifts for the new school at Butera and we are having desks, seats and other equipment provided. We would like to buy some sporting equipment for them in time to come.
